## 1 POST-DOCTORAL RESEARCHER IN 'REGULATION'

In the **Research Program "Regulation"** (Head: **Dr. Francesc Trillas**) at the IEB, we are seeking one economist at post-doc level (full-time). The successful candidate will have the opportunity to work on research topics in the area of 'Regulation', and to carry out independent work on his or her own area of research. The tasks specifically associated with the position are:

- (i) Writing and publishing research papers
- (ii) Providing support for the management of IEB's events and publications
- (iii) Possibly, some graduate teaching

Candidates should have a Ph.D., and well-founded knowledge of micro-economics, industrial organization and applied econometrics. All applicants with a public economics background will be considered, but priority will be given to applicants working in the following fields:

- (i) Telecommunications
- (ii) Energy
- (iii) Political Economy and regulatory institutions

A good knowledge of quantitative methods and management skills are required. Experience in research and/or teaching is an advantage. Fluency in English is a prerequisite, and some knowledge of Spanish is welcome.

The position is for 3 years. The successful candidate would be expected to start in January 2009, although this date is negotiable. The salary is 25,000 euro/year, before tax and employee social security contributions, and is fully funded by the IEB.

Candidates should provide, together with an application letter: 1) a full CV; 2) a job-market paper; 3) a research summary with a list of publications (including those in preparation); 4) 2 reference letters. Copies of relevant university academic transcripts will be requested at some point of the selection process.
