

**CALL FOR APPLICATIONS:
POSTDOCTORAL POSITIONS IN ECONOMICS**

The University of Barcelona School of Economics invites applications for 4 three-year postdoctoral positions beginning in September 2022. These positions may lead to an assistant professorship when the candidate receives a positive evaluation, and positions become available.

One of these positions corresponds to the Department of Economics (Section of Public Economics) in the following fields of interest:

- Environmental; Agricultural Economics
- Health; Education; Welfare
- Labor; Demographic Economics
- Political Economy
- Public Economics
- Urban, Rural, Regional Economics

The University of Barcelona is a leading centre in southern Europe, with a strong commitment to excellence in research. UB School of Economics provides an important platform for research and graduate education in Economics, as it encompasses the Masters and the Doctoral programme in Economics (ub.edu/school-economics).

Candidates are expected to show outstanding commitment to research and must have obtained a PhD when taking up the position. Successful applicants will be expected to teach in English in the undergraduate and postgraduate programs, to develop independent research programs achieving international recognition, and to be involved in the school activities.

The successful applicant for the position in the Department of Economics (Section of Public Economics) will have the opportunity to carry out research activities in the framework of the Barcelona Institute of Economics (IEB). The IEBs goals are to promote research excellence in economics, to disseminate its results to society, and to contribute to the debate and decision-making process in economic policy (ieb.ub.edu & twitter.com/FundacioIEB).

Applications should be submitted via EconJobMarket (econjobmarket.org/positions/8038) and must include a cover letter, CV, three letters of recommendation and a copy of the Job Market Paper as well as any other relevant research output.

Interviews will be conducted at the EEA Job Market Virtual Meeting, from December 15th to 18th, 2021. Other arrangements may be possible for short-listed candidates who do not plan to participate in this virtual meeting. Based on the interviews, some candidates will be invited for seminars in January/February.
